Pure Buckwheat (Isn't wheat).

Couscous (Made from pearl millet only).

Beef—Rare/medium-rare.

Well Done Meat (Rare or medium-rare is ok).

Deli Meats... No nitrates or nitrites – Read labels. Tell your butcher NO NITRATES or NITRITES!

NO Carbonated Drinks within 1 hour before, during or 1 hour after meals.
